The ACS will host its 1st Annual Relay for Life in Oroville on May 16th at Bechtel Field (Oroville High School track behind Challenge Charter High School). The relay is a 24 hour event beginning at 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, May 16th through Sunday, May 17th until 10:00 a.m.

The Oroville Women Cancer Support will have a team called “The Warm Fuzzies” at the relay. The first lap will be a survivor’s lap at 10:00 a.m. to celebrate those who have had cancer. OWCS will also have a booth at the event and will be offering ribbons, earrings and survivor kits made by the support group for a small donation.
